Strategic Objective:

The overall objective is to help regional policy-makers to design and implement strategies to **increase the innovation** performance of European regions **in road transport sector** and to contribute to the overall sustainability and competitiveness targets of Lisbon and Gothenburg Agendas.

This shall be achieved by **improving regional public support schemes** for innovationinducing producer services across Europe, **transferring the academic know-how** to regional policy-makers and by **stimulating the design of next-generation cluster** support policies.

Bio - John Murray
