FP7 Calls Update

• REGIONS-2010 call results:

The results of REGIONS-2010-call were presented in the NCPs meeting held in Granada, on 18 March 2010. 35 proposals were submitted, 7 of them are on the main list and 1 in the reserve. The average budget of the projects in the main list is approximately 2.4 million euro and the average consortium consists of 15 partners. The Coordinators come from 5 countries (FR 2, IT 2, NL 1, DE 1, ES 1) and the partners from 19 Member States and Associated Countries. Negotiations are still ongoing. The presentation is available on CORDIS Forum.

• REGIONS-2011 call to be launched in July:

The new call for proposals REGIONS-2011 is expected in July, with deadline on 9 December, and budget 18.66 million euro. This year's topic is "Boosting the competitiveness of transport-related economy: support the innovative capacity of European transport-related industries and businesses, through i.e. the development of green transport systems, intermodal regional transport systems, urban mobility and safety and security". The presentation of J.D. Malo is available on CORDIS Forum.

• New Partner Search from CORDIS:

The New Partner Search of CORDIS is expected to be launched in time for the FP7 calls in July 2010. OPOCE/CORDIS is organising a meeting on 1st July, in Luxembourg, for testing the new service. NCP Networks and CORDIS users will be represented.

• EU meeting for NCPs Networks Coordinators:

The 2nd meeting of NCPs project Coordinators was organised by the European Commission on 5 February 2010. Among the topics discussed were: problems encountered during the implementation of the projects, quality standards (results of former projects were presented), Training Third Countries participation, etc. The minutes are available on TRANS REG intranet.

• OPEN DAYS 2010: 8th European Week of Regions and Cities (Brussels, 4-7 October 2010) 130 seminars and workshops are expected to take place during the 8th European Week of Regions and Cities (OPEN DAYS 2010) on 4-7 October, in Brussels. Research Driven Clusters in Europe

• **IN2WOOD (REGIONS-2009):** The European forest-based sector has to face times of challenge. Wood as a natural resource will play a key role in a sustainable society. Shaping the future markets by strategic integration of research and technological development therefore is a European objective. The European Commission expects substantial effects for the forest-based sector by cross-linking regional clusters. IN2WOOD joins 13 partners in 6 European regions (Banska Bystrica-Slovakia, Carpathia-Ukraine, Grisons-Switzerland, North Rhine-Westphalia-Germany, South Tyrol-Italy and Styria-Austria) to meet the challenges of innovation, competitiveness and sustainability. Additional "mentoring partners" will be selected and integrated into the IN2WOOD work process.

The IN2WOOD coordination activities are carried out by a "triple helix" of research, regional authority and business (SMEs) representing the forest-based cluster in each partner region. Their overall working program involves three elements of the forest-based value chain including resource production: new methods for sustainable forest management, urban timber construction and efficient use of wood energy. These working areas are interrelated by three crosscutting themes: logistic systems for wood mobilization, innovation systems for the energy-efficient use of wood as construction and heating material and a trans-regional information system.

• WasteKIT (REGIONS-2009): Waste management focussing on: Knowledge and Integration to create Transnational economic development:

The project focuses on three drivers: 1. Societal & economic attention for sustainability & specific waste management; 2. Waste management-related regional economic development; 3. Network of networks for European innovation and competitiveness excellence.

The consortium consists of 19 partners from the Netherlands, Italy, Bulgaria and UK, and is coordinated by Amsterdam Innovation Motor. The objectives of the project are:

- To expand ambitions of regions with respect to regional economic development based on waste management RTD, innovation & amp; business creation;

- To expand international mentoring roles of waste management-related actors;

- To create an international role as a European network of (regional) waste management-related clusters.

Development Agency (project leader), Polytechnic University of Timisoara, Interpart Production, and the Association Tehimpuls - Regional Center of Innovation and Technology Transfer. The budget equals to 169 924 euro for the period 2008-2010. The most important results are:

- Creating a cluster management unit, in synergy with the overall activity of the ssociation "Automotivest",

- Development of a multi-year action plan for the cluster, as well as marketing and internationalization strategies,

- Elaboration of a study of the automotive sector at regional level, Creation of databases on a) companies active in the industry at the regional level, b) R&D institutions in the region and relevant innovative products for the automotive industry,

- Drawing up a guide on promoting cooperation between the companies R&D institutions and businesses in the West Region, with emphasis on the situation in the automotive sector,

- Supporting the implementation of a pilot project for cooperation between the Polytechnic University of Timisoara and the company Interpart Production focused on techniques for generating complex paths for CNC machines,

- Implementation of a comprehensive package of information and communication activities addressed to various types of cluster stakeholders (thematic workshops, expert roundtables, site visits, jour fixes, etc.)

- Creation of specific communication tools (newsletter "Autoclustervest", portal).
